Training will include:

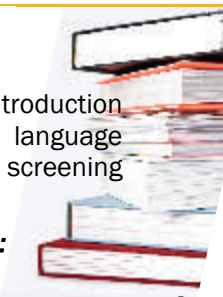
A brief review of the introductory course then an introduction and practice of more advanced techniques in the language continuum. The use of the dictation paragraph and screening procedures will also be presented.

- Integration of new learning throughout the format.
- Instruction in critical thinking skills necessary for reading, writing and speaking.
- Current research in dyslexia.
- Administration and Evaluation of Slingerland® Screening Materials.

THIRD YEAR:

- Evaluations of lesson plans, materials and teaching stations.
- Evaluations of delivery of planned lessons.
