

SLINGERLAND® SUMMER SCHOOL FOR CHILDREN at Our Lady of the Lake Parish School

Parents frequently ask questions about the Slingerland® summer program for children. Is it right for my child? Does his or her teacher recommend it? The intent of the program is two-fold. First, teachers enroll in graduate study to learn the Slingerland® instructional methodology to teach reading and language arts. Secondly, students enroll to work with the teachers and in doing so they receive help and reinforcement in handwriting, reading and spelling. Students receive daily instruction from a master teacher in a small classroom setting and daily tutoring from one of the individual teachers taking the course. They may also work in a small group with a teacher taking the advanced training. Your child's teacher can also help you decide if it would be right for them.

Students who will benefit most from this training include:

- Those with average to superior intelligence who are not achieving in the skills of language — reading, spelling, penmanship, oral and/or written expression.
- Children with language/learning difficulties.
- Those having a familial pattern of language weaknesses.
- Those who show weaknesses in the Auditory and/or Visual modalities which interfere with understanding and using language for spelling and reading.
- Those with Kinesthetic Motor modality weakness that interferes with recall of the sequence of movement involved in spoken language or in letter formation for penmanship.
